



2010 Chattahoochee District Honor Unit Criteria for Packs



Unit Leadership

- Each Den has at least one TRAINED den leader (they have completed Cub Scout Position Specific training)
- Appoint a Pack Trainer to keep track of adult training status and encourage adult leaders to get trained. The name of your Trainer should be forwarded to your Unit Commissioner.
- Hold at least THREE planned committee meetings over the year
- Recharter your pack **BY RECHARTER DAY** in December www.CDBSA.org/Membership/Recharter.htm
- Do at least THREE of the following:
 - At least 2 adults from your Pack attend the District Recognition Banquet (Godsend nominees should attend)
 - Establish a succession plan by the end of the school year (who will be new den leaders, etc.)
 - Submit/update the Yellow Pages entry for your pack www.CDBSA.org/Membership/membership.htm
 - submit a District Award of Merit nomination **by Recharter Day** www.cdbsa.org/Pages/Honors.htm
 - submit Pack Godsend Award to the District Commissioner **by Recharter Day**
 - submit Silver Beaver nomination to the Council Service Center by **Oct 31** www.cdbsa.org/Pages/Honors.htm

Provide a well rounded program for your Scouts

- Establish your National Quality Unit objectives **by APRIL 1** www.scouting.org/Awards/CentennialAwards.aspx
- Achieve National Centennial Quality Unit goals www.scouting.org/Awards/CentennialAwards.aspx
- Create or update an annual budget for the pack
- Create or update an annual event calendar for the pack
- Do at least FOUR of the following "traditional events"
 - Observe Scout Sunday/Sabbath (early February)
 - conduct a Pack Derby (pinewood, raingutter, space, etc)
 - Have a Pack Blue and Gold Banquet
 - Conduct a Cross-Over ceremony for exiting Webelos (can be done in conjunction with Blue and Gold or other activity)
 - Conduct a graduation ceremony for the scouts as they move to the next grade-rank.
- SERVICE: Do at least TWO of the following:
 - Perform a pack service project (#1) (Clean up days at the church, river, etc.)
 - Perform a second pack service project (#2) (Clean up days at the church, river, etc.)
 - Conduct a Scouting for Food drive (this is in addition to service projects)
 - Participate in a community event as a pack in uniform (Roswell Youth Day Parade, post flags at a local cemetery at Memorial Day, etc.)
- Have at least one Pack family outing or camping event (pack participation at district or council events can count towards this)
- Do at least THREE of the following:
 - Have a second pack family outing during the school year
 - Have at least one [Pack Summertime](#) event (e.g. such as bike rodeo, picnic, hike, camping, etc.)
 - Have the Pack participate in some [BSA Centennial Celebration](#) event
 - Have your Unit Commissioner conduct a uniform inspection at a pack event
 - At least 10% of the pack's Scouts earn the relevant religious emblem (ever, not just this year)
- Provide the opportunity for every Scout in the pack to view the Youth Protection video for Cub Scout aged youth, "It Happened to Me" (An option is to make sure parents know it can be borrowed from the Pack)

Recruiting and Retention

- Conduct at least one recruiting event (Race to Scouting)

Support District and Council program events

- Cub Camps – Do at least ONE of the following
 - Have least 10% of registered youth attend Cub Scout Day/Twilight Camp **PLUS provide the required amount of adult support**
 - At least 10% of Webelos attend the Atlanta Area Council's Webelos Encampment
 - At least 10% of Cubs attend Atlanta Area Council's Wolf-Bear Encampment
- Do at least ONE of the following:
 - Pack sponsors a booth, station or class at a council or district event (e.g. Cavalcade, Roswell Youth Day, Cuboree, Cub World, ScoutFest, etc.)
 - Pack hosts a Round Table break-out session
- Do at least TWO of the following:
 - Have a leader serve in a district or council position (training team, district committee, commissioner, cub camp staff, Scouters' academy trainer, etc.)
 - Have a second leader (different person) serve in a district or council position
 - The pack's Charter Organization Representative attend the District Business Meeting in the fall and vote on the slate for the following year's district committee
 - Have a presentation of the Unit Charter to the Chartering Organization

Support Council Fundraising Activities

- Conduct a [Friends of Scouting](#) campaign in your unit (typically at Blue and Gold Banquet, pack meeting, etc.)
- Participate in the Council popcorn fundraising program (sell TrailsEnd* popcorn)
- Do TWO of the following:
 - At least 50% of families participate in the [Friends of Scouting](#) program (return a pledge card)
 - Pack meets or exceeds its FOS goal (assigned by the District Executive)
 - At least 50% of your Scouts participate in selling popcorn (they sell SOMETHING)
 - Your unit at equals or surpasses last year's popcorn sales in dollars

Leader Training - "Every Scout Deserves Trained Leaders"

- CM, ACM, CC, and all Den Leaders leaders [FULLY trained](#) FOR THEIR CURRENT POSITION (CSLS, Youth Protection)
- All registered adults completed Youth Protection Training for Adults within the last 2 years. Unit Commissioner or [OLC.Scouting.Org](#)
- At least 50% of all registered committee members in Fast Start and CSLS (committee break-out).
- Do at least TWO of the following
 - At least 2 BALOO trained leaders in the pack (see the training section at [www.CDBSA.org](#))
 - At least 1 adult current with CPR training (CPR Saturday is March 7, see [www.GoodTurn.net](#) for more info)
 - At least 1 adult current with First Aid training (such as American Red Cross First Aid)
 - At least 1 adult current with [on-line Hazardous Weather](#) training.
- Do at least THREE of the following
 - Have Pack representation at FIVE or more of the monthly Round Tables
 - Have at least FOUR different people attend at least one Round Table
 - A second adult per ALL dens has completed some form of Cub Scout Leader Specific training.
 - At least 5% of pack leaders [Wood Badge](#) Trained (ever, not just this year)
 - At least 25% of eligible Leaders (CM, ACM, CC, DL's WDL) earn the [Adult Leader Knot](#) for their service over the 2009-10 school year.
