## Introduction To Outdoor Leader Skills (ITOLS)

<b>Who Should Go:</b>	Scoutmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters, Troop Committee members and other adults who expect to work with the boys in developing their basic camp and out-of-door skills. Venturing Leaders working with High Adventure Crews also are strongly encouraged to attend, especially if these Crews have Leaders who are new to Scouting.
<b>What To Learn:</b>	Instructors will help you learn how to set up camp, cook, work with woods tools and about ropes, first aid, planning campfire programs, map reading and compass skills, hiking and packing techniques, nature identification, and Leave No Trace. Each outdoor session will bring to life the pages of the Boy Scout Handbook to help you deliver the promise of Scouting to yourself and the youth you serve. It covers the outdoor skills expected of a First Class Scout and will increase your comfort level and give you confidence as a trained, skilled leader. This program will also give you the opportunity to work with other Scout leaders, meet new friends, and reinforce skill techniques with fellow unit leaders. <i>And...Have Fun!</i>
